banana fertilizer recipe



Ingredients:

- Banana peels
- Water

Notes:

Recommended Proportion: use a ratio of one banana peel to one gallon of water.

Recommended Plants:

- Particularly beneficial for potassium-hungry plants or those needing a boost in overall nutrient levels.

Instructions:

- Cut banana peels into small pieces.

- 3. Let the mixture sit for a few days to allow the nutrients to leach into the water.
- 4. Strain the liquid and dilute it with water (1:5 ratio) before using it to water your plants.
