

garlic fertilizer recipe



Ingredients:

- Garlic cloves
- Water

Notes:

- **Pest Repellent:** Garlic contains natural compounds that deter pests and fungi.
- **Soil Health:** Enriches soil with nutrients and beneficial microorganisms.

Usage Recommendations:

Use garlic fertilizer as a natural pest deterrent and soil conditioner. Dilute the garlic-infused water with additional water (1:5 ratio) and spray it directly onto plant foliage to deter pests like aphids, whiteflies, and fungal infections. Apply every two weeks during the growing season or as needed.

Instructions:

1. Crush or finely chop garlic cloves to release their oils and active compounds.
2. Place the crushed garlic in a container and cover it with water.
3. Let the mixture steep for at least 24 hours or up to a week to allow the garlic to infuse into the water.
4. Strain the garlic-infused water and dilute it with additional water (1:5 ratio) before use.
5. Use a spray bottle to apply the diluted garlic fertilizer directly onto plant foliage, focusing on areas prone to pests or fungal infections.
